Fender Flap Installation Guide

Prepare the Guide:

Print and cut out the guide below or use the flaps as a physical reference.

Remove Wheels (Optional):

Remove the bike wheels for easier access, or be cautious not to drill into the tire.

Mark Drill Spots:

Place painter's tape on the fenders where you'll drill. Mark the center of the fender or visually align it (see "Honjo Fender Installation" by SimWorks for reference).

Position the Guide:

Align the guide with the bottom of the fender, ensuring marks A and B are transferred accurately to the fender.

Double-Check Alignment:

Confirm that the registration marks are even.

Drill Holes:

Carefully drill two holes in the fender, sized to fit your zip ties or bolts. Avoid drilling into the tire or your hand!

Attach Flaps:

Use one of the following methods:

Two zip ties around the edges
One zip tie across the center
Two button-head bolts with nuts

Finish the Installation:

Trim, file, or melt the ends of the zip ties flush for a clean finish.
